1 Chenin Blanc Flying Griffin Douglas Green, South Africa A lively mouthful of mangoes and passion fruits. A really tasty example of this undervalued grape variety. Dry, with a soft fragrant and rounded finish. Ideal with lighter dishes.	£3.05	£4.00	£11.85
2 El Coto Rioja, Spain Rioja blanco from the Viura grape variety delivers a crisp, dry style. With an intense bouquet of acacia and apple. Followed by delicious flavours in the mouth with notes of sweet citrus fruit.	£3.10	£4.15	£12.50

5 Sauvignon Blanc Hacienda del Rey Canata, Chile Intensely young and vibrant, full of lemongrass and fresh asparagus, followed by balanced acidity and a crisp finish to this delightfully exuberant wine. 8 Sauvignon Blanc Conway Hills, New Zealand This wine was harvested from Marlborough vineyards situated in the heart of the famous Cloudy Bay District. 9 Gavi Antario DOCG Piemonte, Italy Seductive and suitably elegant for any occasion. A really tasty example of this grape variety, Cortese. 10 Chablis Domaine de Vauroux, France A true classic, dry yet full of soft ripe rich fruit with a balanced savoury nuttiness at the finish, from a top Domaine. A must for those Burgundy lovers!			£19.50
11 Sancerre Domaine Durand Loire, France A seductive Sauvignon with the aroma of gooseberries and classic gunflint flavours. A fine example from the Loire valley. Dry and crisp with an elegant finish.			£19.95
12 Semillon The Colonial Estate Barossa Valley, Australia This is a small estate purchased by the owner of Chateau Teyssier in Saint Emilion. He is now becoming a flying winemaker, and produces super wines in both hemispheres. Rich ripe honeydew melon and exotic fruits followed by sweet summer berries and complimented by soft French oak. 13 Chassagne-Montrachet Louis Latour, France This is serious white Burgundy at its seductive best. The village of Chassagne Montrachet is the last and most southerly of the three great wine making appellations in the Cote de Beaune. The wines are opulent with classic flavours of butter, toast, spicy pine kernels and tropical fruits. Dry yet rich with a full well-balanced texture, having benefited from 12 months ageing in oak barrels.			£32.00

| 17 Zinfandel Cutler Crest, California
Youthful, brambly jammy fruits are plentiful. The Zinfandel grape has been adopted by California, and the style of wine is very easy drinking with soft tannins and a lively finish. | £3.05 | £4.00 | £11.85 |
| 18 Cabernet Merlot Shiraz Five Mile Point, Australia
Delicately ripe, spiced summer fruits are stunningly displayed, characteristically warm mellow tannins lingering on the soft, dry palate. Very quaffable. | £3.15 | £4.20 | £12.45 |
| 19 Merlot Canata Hacienda del Rey
The wine has an intense flavour of cherries, raspberries and even chocolate! Followed by a spicy, well-balanced harmonious and complex finish. Definitely a wine to tempt the taste buds. | £3.25 | £4.35 | £12.95 |
| 20 Cabernet Sauvignon Flying Griffin Douglas Green, South Africa
Intensely aromatic, with terrific nuances of cassis and blackberry followed by typical flavours of mint and sage. Full bodied with soft tannins and a concentrated palate. | £3.40 | £4.55 | £13.50 |
| 21 Chateau de Fayolle Bergerac, France
Beautifully ripe plummy bilberries are gloriously seen in their droves. Warm mellow tannins lingering on the soft, dry palate. Produced from the classic Bordeaux blend. The definition of Old World wine has been redefined. | £3.75 | £5.00 | £14.85 |
| 22 Marques de Grinon Crianza Rioja, Spain
A truly distinctive 'new wave' style, made from the Tempranillo grapes, the wines most remarkable characteristics is its combination of youth with the maturity of oak ageing. With aromas of cigar box followed by a well balanced yet smooth and velvety finish. | £4.10 | £5.55 | £16.50 |
| 23 Pinot Noir Conway Hills, New Zealand
This wine shows an intense nose of raspberries and Black Doris plums with spicy, minty, earthy and stemmy characters. The palate is medium bodied with soft tannins and features sweet fruit backed up by black pepper, cloves and spice. There is a good balance between fruit and oak with lingering flavours on the finish. An ideal accompaniment to meat and game dishes. | | | £17.95 |
| 24 Shiraz The Gun Shearer, Australia
This is the epitome of McLaren Vale Shiraz, named in memory of the shearers who achieved the highest tally of shorn sheep. An astonishingly broad range of flavours, rich cracked black pepper spiciness followed by dark plums and blueberry, with a hint of chocolate on the palate. Full bodied yet soft and easy to drink. | | | £22.95 |
| 25 Chateauneuf du Pape Domaine Roger Perrin Rhône, France
Full of spice and pepper, displaying the power and exuberant rich fruit typical of this Rhône village. Dry, with plenty of flavours and a perfect finish. From a producer famous for making top quality wine albeit in small quantities. | | | £24.95 |
| 26 Chateau Clerc-Milon 5ème Cru Classe Pauillac 1998
In 1970 Baron Philippe de Rothschild bought this medium sized estate, tucked between Mouton and Lafite and said to have first rate soils. The potential of which have never been realised. After much replanting, mostly with Cabernet Sauvignon, the hunch seems to have been proved correct, as Clerc-Milon is now an outstanding Pauillac. Impressively structured and with much elegance and complexity the wines can be drunk relatively young, although they do have the ability to age well. | | | £32.00 |
